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












Building Collaboration with Tech

...ushered in a culture of collaboration






Four years ago...

Educators shared ways to use edtech to create routinized experiences for learners while designing for reusability





Just Having OER Available Not Enough



Service learning that leads to high-quality OER

Build, share, and adapt lessons powered by OER

Service Learning to Address Resource Gaps

Adapt + Remix Content

Resources exist, but if adapted they could be made more usable and accessible.

Create New Content

Limited resources exist or are missing key components, so new content is needed.

Curate Existing Content

"As-is" resources are available, but they may need to be organized to be more usable.

How can we make better use of teachers' time and expertise?




Adapting + Remixing Content

Why this is needed...

- Resource suitability
- Access / usability of resources
- "Granularity" of existing OER


Examples...

- Adjusting content for readability, relevance
- Digitization of content



The Result?

Teachers created over 1,000 mobile-friendly, supplemental reading activities that can be completed independently or in a classroom setting.





Why this is needed...

- Limited/lack of relevant content
- Resources that fit new models

- Activities that develop digital skills and *digital resilience*







The result?

Teachers design reusable OER while leveraging high-use, high-impact instructional routines.

If a digital illiterate can learn as much as I did, then I recommend this type of instruction to anyone.


Curate Existing Content

Why this is needed...

- Quality OER exists, but retrieval can be challenging
- No "one-size-fits-all" resource for all learners

Examples

- Khan Academy for adult ed
- Organized digital skills OER






Key takeaways...

- Benchmark tasks and accountability


Lesson #2: Planning and Clear Structure is Key

- Establish a regular cadence for check-ins




Sessions Every Other Week with Gradual Assignments


