

WHAT TO REMEMBER

STUDENT PROGRESS REPORT

- Teachers and admins have access to this report.
 - Shows data from one specific subject area.
 - Displays students in classes or assigned to you as the primary teacher.

IMPLEMENTATION BEST PRACTICES

STUDENT PROGRESS REPORT

- See what teacher intervention is needed:
 - Is study time too low?
 - Is the last login not recent enough?
 - Are there a low amount of skill gains?
 - Is the practice test score showing readiness?

- On-screenreporting whilestudents work.
- Determine where students are in their learning.

What - (What content do I plan to use from this curriculum? Is there a specific piece or feature that I want to use?

When - (When will I check this Report? What days? For how long? What is the schedule for providing feedback to students?)

How - (What are three ways to incorporate this into my classroom? What steps will I take to provide FAST feedback to students?)

WHAT TO REMEMBER

LEARNING PLAN REPORT

Shows content from one specific subject area.

Ways a learning plan is created and updated:

- Initial Assessments
- Practice Tests
- Manual changes by a teacher or administrator

IMPLEMENTATION BEST PRACTICES

LEARNING PLAN REPORT



Review a student's learning plan.



Discuss with the student about where they are and what is coming.



Tailor a learning plan using GED Ready or HiSET OPT data points.

PROVIDE FEEDBACK

How do you provide feedback to your students?





PROVIDE FEEDBACK

What are ways to provide feedback?

- Daily shoutouts
- Look at reports/activity, write shoutouts or names on the board for students to see
- Group praise based on diligence/engagement of in-class or other activity
- Study time, lessons completed, HSE readiness based on practice tests



PROVIDE FEEDBACK

How you can incorporate Essential Education

- LMS messaging
- One-on-one conferences discussing report data
 - Study Time, Student Summary, and Student Overview
- Grade students' practice test essays
 - Use system's pre-generated feedback
- Discuss the progress widget with students
